REVISED BRIEF FOR TREE SURVEY

Longhope Parish Council would like to carry out a comprehensive survey of all the trees on land it owns or manages in Longhope parish.

Tasks

1. An inspection of all trees on the following sites:
 - Land to the rear of the Latchen Room (village hall)
 - The village allotments opposite
 - The bankside along Brookend, behind the allotments
 - Longhope Recreation Ground on Church Road
 - The copse at the summit of May Hill
2. A survey report identifying and mapping all the trees, and noting:
 - Location
 - Species
 - Age
 - Condition
 - Safe useful life expectancy
 - Any recommended work (safety or maintenance)
 - Priority for work over the next three years
 - Any other comments

Please see attached location maps and identification list for trees in Longhope village. For May Hill, as the 90-plus trees in the copse are close together and look very much the same, we would like to vary the brief to ask for marking of trees that need attention rather than mapping, noting that a number are already suffering from red needle blight and have a shorter life expectancy accordingly.

Timeline

The survey should be carried out as soon as possible.
