

Longhope Parish Council is seeking to appoint a part-time handyman and street cleaner, to handle the increasing number of small tasks around the village.

The job includes but is not limited to:

- Street cleaning tasks to District Council specifications
- Clearing storm debris from roads and waterways
- Making minor pavement and path repairs
- Occasional mowing of grass verges
- Monitoring and reporting access and safety issues around the parish

Candidates will need:

- Experience of practical outdoor maintenance tasks
- Experience of working within the community
- Capacity to self-manage and work unsupervised
- Understanding of health and safety
- Access to transport

Knowledge of Longhope village would be desirable, but not essential.

The position is part-time at 4 hours per week, hours / days to be agreed, with a 6 months' probationary period. Salary starts from £9.46 per hour. Tools, personal protective equipment (PPE) and training will be provided.
